1 - M  thode Classique:

```
CREATE TABLE TEST.TABLE1 ( AN NUMERIC ( 4, 0 ), MOIS NUMERIC ( 2, 0 ), DEBUT  
NUMERIC ( 8, 0 ), FIN NUMERIC ( 8, 0 ));
```

2 - M  thode CREATE LIKE:

```
CREATE TABLE TEST.TABLE2 LIKE TEST.TABLE3; NB: Utile dans les cas o  1 les champs  
pourraient changer de nom dans le futur.
```

3 - M  thode CREATE AS SELECT (avec donn  es)

```
CREATE TABLE EMPLOYEE3 AS (SELECT PROJNO, PROJNAME, DEPTNO FROM EMPLOYEE  
WHERE DEPTNO = &#39;D11&#39;) WITH DATA;
```

4 - M  thode CREATE AS SELECT (sans donn  es)

```
CREATE TABLE EMPLOYEE3 AS (SELECT PROJNO, PROJNAME, DEPTNO FROM  
EMPLOYEE) WITH NO DATA;
```
